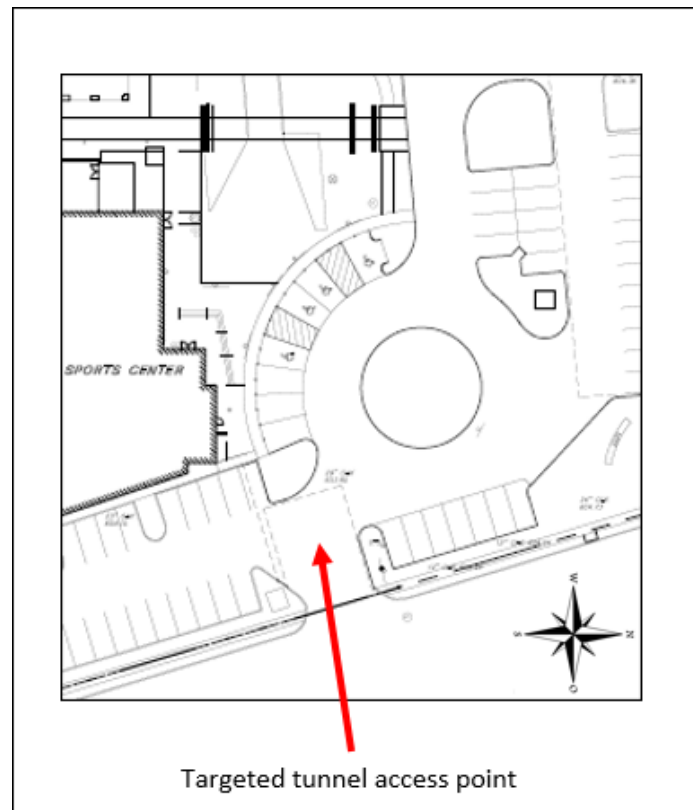

Dear Parishioners,

I draw your attention to the City of Dallas Wastewater project currently underway, coming north & east under Bachman Creek. Today we received a status report that the work underground has gone well and that above-ground work is about to be started in the area just east and south of the roundabout at Inwood and Harvest Hill as seen in the map below. Starting tomorrow, Tuesday, July 11, and continuing through around July 25, a 12ft. wide trench will be dug to connect to the tunnel which has already been excavated under the creek. To accomplish this the areas marked by the dotted lines will be barricaded off from traffic from Tuesday to Friday this week, from Monday to Friday next week, and from Monday to Wednesday of the following week. The barricades will be pulled back on Friday evenings to permit the flow of one lane of traffic over the weekends. During these weekdays traffic flow in a north/south direction to or from the roundabout area will be disrupted.

The City's General Contractors are hopeful that all their work would be completed and the area resurfaced with concrete by July 25 or 26. If the resurfacing with concrete cannot be accomplished by then, they will cover the hole with steel plates to reopen the area to two-way traffic for the Youth Convocation starting on July 27. There will not be any work conducted at this location between July 27 – 30.
